## **Camping Rules & Regulations**

- No vehicles may be parked or staged at any time on or adjacent to Indian Springs Road, nor on any other roadway surrounding Phoenix International Raceway property. Signs posted along Indian Springs Road and surrounding roadways that read "No Stopping Standing Parking Anytime" were placed there by the proper county or municipal jurisdictions in the interest of public safety. Campers who arrive and park or stage along any roadway prior to Phoenix International Raceway authorized on property staging may be subject to law enforcement action including citations or having their vehicle(s) towed. PIR strongly recommends that race fans planning to stage their RV make plans to arrive during the posted authorized staging time period.
- Each reserved marked camping space is for 1 camping (livable) unit and 1 tow vehicle only. A reserved RV and vehicle pass is required. Please note we have a new pass style this year. Carefully remove the permit from the liner and affix the pass in the lower left-hand corner of your windshield (driver side). RVs being dropped off by a rental company are required to have the original reserved RV pass as copies will not be accepted. The original RV pass must be affixed to the RV/vehicle at time of check in, and remain affixed on the RV/vehicle while parked on property.
- Camping unit, equipment and tow vehicle must all fit within the marked space. Additional vehicles may park in Yellow 1. No overnight camping is allowed in the Yellow 1 parking lot.
- •Each RV/vehicle must have an unreserved parking pass to access the unreserved camping area. Each livable unit or trailer 10' or more in length, will also require an unreserved parking pass/decal.
- Unreserved RV parking is first-come, first-serve. No roping off or "saving" spaces. If multiple RVs wish to camp together, they must arrive together. Note that space is limited and may not accommodate all RVs in a group.
- An unreserved RV campsite is approximately 20'x40'. Staff will monitor the area and remove any materials used to mark off excessive space. Please do no block ingress or egress to crosswalks or tram stops.
- Fire lanes and roadways cannot be blocked at any time. Please park all campers and vehicles in designated camping areas or spaces only. Do not block roadways. Activities in roadways that interfere with traffic or emergency access will not be permitted.
- Quiet hours are from 12am 6am. Please be courteous to your neighbors and keep music/talking to a level only heard in your RV site as to not disturb other guests. Please do not run generators during quiet hours.
- Spot lights, lasers, loud music, PA systems, amplified equipment, live bands or other activities that interfere with other quests are prohibited.
- Unauthorized vehicles including, but not limited to, golf carts, electric or gas scooters of any kind, sand rails, dirt bikes, all-terrain vehicles (ATVs or ATCs) or any off-road recreational vehicles are prohibited on PIR property. Single person electric convenience vehicles are allowed to assist guests with disabilities. A vehicle that is street legal or licensed to operate on the roadway does not mean it is allowed on PIR property. PIR will review vehicles on a case by case basis and reserves the right to deem them unauthorized.
- Please do not use the tram roadway for walking, jogging, bike riding, skateboarding or other activity while trams are in service. It is important that the tram roadways are kept clear while trams are in service.
- Waste water dumping is a violation of PIR policy and Arizona State law (A.R.S. 13-1603). Any dumping of waste water will result in prosecution, ejection from the property and renewal privileges will be revoked. Please be respectful of the environment and your neighbors and please place all trash in trash cans.
- Campfires on open, unprotected ground are PROHIBITED. Campfires in approved above ground containers are allowed. Fires underneath awnings, dining canopies or bonfires will not be allowed. Unusually dry conditions or county regulations may result in the prohibition of all open fires. Please do not place hot coals in trash cans or dumpsters.
- No stakes may be driven into the ground or into any paved area. Any markings or writing on the ground, pavement or any other PIR property is prohibited.
- Offensive signs, flags or banners, lewd behavior and profanity, as determined by PIR in its sole discretion, will not be tolerated.
- For your safety and that of other fans around you, only non-metallic flagpoles are permitted on PIR property. Please be aware of power lines and hazards at all times. Flagpoles are not permitted within 20 feet of an overhead power line.

- Carbon monoxide is dangerous and can cause death or bodily harm. For your own safety and the safety of those camping around you, please make sure that all generators, stoves and related items are accompanied by proper ventilation systems. If your generator is not ventilated properly you will be required to correct immediately or turn it off for the remainder of the event.
- No weapons of any kind are permitted on PIR property.
- Riding a bicycle on property is a privilege and can be restricted or eliminated if reckless behavior is observed. Vehicles and pedestrians have the right of way. Bicycles are not permitted through the grandstand gates or on tram roadways while trams are in service. Walking of bicycles is allowed in vendor row but riding is prohibited. Bicycles are not permitted through the Fanatics store (merchandise/souvenir area). As in all matters, parents and adult guardians are responsible for the actions of their minor children.
- Unauthorized sales, marketing or corporate hospitality are not allowed on PIR property.
- Phoenix International Raceway ("Track") strictly prohibits the use of any unmanned aerial vehicles ("UAV"), also known as a drone, for any purpose whatsoever on Track Property. A UAV for purposes of this policy is any <u>aircraft</u> without a human <u>pilot</u> aboard. Track personnel may remove anyone using a UAV on Track property and/or confiscate the UAV until the event is over.
- Fireworks, sky lanterns, water balloon launchers, super soakers, inflatable blimps or other items deemed dangerous will not be allowed on PIR property.
- Pets must be leashed/controlled at all times. Pet waste must be properly disposed. Pets with excessive barking or aggressive behavior will be required to leave the property.
- Tampering with or moving light towers, port-a-johns, trash cans or any other PIR property is prohibited.
- PIR is not liable for lost or stolen items.
- PIR will not & cannot verify a third party sale of a ticket. We encourage you when purchasing a ticket to purchase from an authorized ticket seller. Tickets obtained from sources other than PIR and its affiliates may be lost, stolen or counterfeit, and in such cases will not be honored. Tickets may not be sold at a price higher than printed on the ticket. Tickets may not be resold on Speedway property. It's unlawful to obtain or attempt to obtain admission by fraud. (A.R.S. 13-2008)
- PIR reserves the right to amend or implement rules at any time.
- RVs must exit the facility by noon following the final day of racing.
- PIR strives to operate a safe environment. PIR does not discriminate, but reserves the right to refuse service and admittance to any person if actions are deemed malicious, inappropriate or abusive towards staff and/or other guests. Any violations of the camping rules and regulations may result in loss of event weekend access and renewal privileges being revoked.

## **Infield Camping Rules & Regulations**

- Each reserved marked camping space is for 1 camping (livable) unit. An infield RV parking pass is required. Please note we have a new pass style this year. Carefully remove the permit from the liner and affix the pass in the lower left-hand corner of your windshield (driver side). RVs being dropped off by a rental company are required to have the original infield RV parking pass as copies will not be accepted. The original infield RV parking pass must be affixed to the RV/vehicle at time of check in, and remain affixed while parked on property.
- Camping unit, equipment and vehicle (if infield vehicle parking pass is purchased) must all fit within the marked space. Additional vehicles may park in the Citrus parking lot outside gate 8. No overnight camping is allowed in the Citrus parking lot.
- Quiet hours are from 12am 6am. Please be courteous to your neighbors and keep music/talking to a level only heard in your RV site as to not disturb other guests. Please do not run generators during quiet hours.
- Infield access requires guest to have one of the following: Infield wristband, daily admission ticket for the weekend plus a pre-race pit pass OR a proper credential. Infield wristbands are non-transferable. Cut, taped or transferred wristbands will be confiscated and guests will not be allowed in the infield.

- Unauthorized vehicles including, but not limited to, golf carts, electric or gas scooters of any kind, sand rails and dirt bikes, all-terrain vehicles (ATVs or ATCs) or any off-road recreational vehicles are prohibited on PIR property. Single person electric convenience vehicles are allowed to assist guests with disabilities. A vehicle that is street legal or licensed to operate on the roadway does not mean it is allowed on PIR property. PIR will review vehicles on a case by case basis and reserves the right to deem them unauthorized
- Fire lanes and roadways cannot be blocked at any time. Activities in roadways that interfere with traffic or emergency access will not be permitted.
- Open campfires are not permitted in the infield. Grills are permitted but excessive smoke is not allowed during track activity.
- For your safety and that of fans around you, only non-metallic flagpoles are permitted on PIR property. Please be aware of power lines and hazards at all times. Flagpoles are not permitted within 20 feet of an overhead power line. All flags should be lowered during any on track activity.
- No weapons of any kind are permitted on PIR property (A.R.S. 4-229).
- Carbon monoxide is dangerous and can cause death or bodily harm. For your own safety and those camping around you, please make sure that all generators, stoves and related items are accompanied by proper ventilation systems. If your generator is not ventilated properly you will be required to correct immediately or turn it off for the remainder of the event.
- Bicycles are permitted in the infield, but please use caution when riding. Riding a bicycle on property is a privilege and can be restricted or eliminated if reckless behavior is observed. Vehicles and pedestrians have the right of way. Bicycles are not permitted on the racing surface, pit road or garages at any time. As in all matters, parents and adult guardians are responsible for the actions of their minor children.
- Phoenix International Raceway ("Track") strictly prohibits the use of any unmanned aerial vehicles ("UAV"), also known as a drone, for any purpose whatsoever on Track Property. A UAV for purposes of this policy is any <u>aircraft</u> without a human <u>pilot</u> aboard. Track personnel may remove anyone using a UAV on Track property and/or confiscate the UAV until the event is over.
- Offensive signs, flags or banners, lewd behavior and profanity, as determined by PIR in its sole discretion, will not be tolerated.
- No stakes may be driven into the ground or into any paved area. Any markings or writing on the ground, pavement or any other PIR property is prohibited.
- No structures, canopies, scaffolds, platforms or umbrellas are allowed on top of RVs. If something is determined to be blocking the view of guests, PIR reserves the right to request or remove the item(s) obstructing the view.
- Waste water dumping is a violation of PIR policy and Arizona State law (A.R.S. 13-1603). Any dumping of waste water will result in prosecution, ejection from the property and renewal privileges will be revoked. Please be respectful of the environment and your neighbors and please place all trash in trash cans.
- Unauthorized sales, marketing or corporate hospitality are not allowed on PIR property.
- Fireworks, sky lanterns, water balloon launchers, super soakers, inflatable blimps or other items deemed dangerous will not be allowed on PIR property.
- Pets must be leashed/controlled at all times. Pet waste must be properly disposed. Pets with excessive barking or aggressive behavior will be required to leave the property.
- Tampering with or moving light towers, port-a-johns, trash cans or any other PIR property is prohibited. Please do not place hot coals in any trash cans or dumpsters.
- Spot lights, lasers, loud music, PA systems or other items or activities that interfere with event activity or other guests are prohibited.
- PIR is not liable for lost or stolen items.
- PIR will not & cannot verify a third party sale of a ticket. We encourage you when purchasing a ticket to purchase from an authorized ticket seller. Tickets obtained from sources other than PIR and its affiliates may be lost, stolen or counterfeit, and in such cases will not be honored. Tickets may not be sold at a price higher than printed on the ticket. Tickets may not be resold on Speedway property. It's unlawful to obtain or attempt to obtain admission by fraud. (A.R.S. 13-2008)

- PIR reserves the right to amend or implement rules at any time.
- RVs must exit the facility by noon following the final day of racing.
